

## **Cleaning Instructions**

- Do <u>NOT</u> use acids or abrasives (cleaners or scrub pads).
- Diamond bond does not eliminate the need for routine maintenance, regular maintenance with safe cleaning products is needed to keep surfaces clear.
- Using a squeegee on a daily basis on your glass greatly reduces maintenance efforts. We recommend a high quality, professional squeegee, like this one:
  Squeegee link-Unger Professional Steel Squeegee with Bonus Rubber, 16"

## Cleaning Shower Glass, Sinks, and Toilets after Sealing

- 1. Use <u>Diamond Bond Cleaner & Revitalizer™</u> and #98 scrub pad to clean shower glass, sinks, and toilets. Purchase <u>Diamond Bond Cleaner & Revitalizer™</u> at our website diamondbondoregon.com
- 2. Steps to cleaning:
  - Wet surface
  - Spray cleaner
  - Scrub surface with #98 scrub pad
  - Rinse and dry surface with squeegee or microfiber cloth

## Cleaning Shower Natural Stone, Tile, and Grout after Sealing

- 1. We recommend Stonetech™ Revitalizer-Cleaner & Protector, Concentrate Citrus Scent, 1 Gallon You can purchase it here:

    - For shower cleaning-mix as a "wet" cleaner. Wet surface, apply cleaner, scrub with #98 scrub pad & grout brush. We recommend this brush:

    - For all other natural stone and tile & grout mix and use as a spray & wipe cleaner. For occasional heavier cleaning of these surfaces use #98 scrub pad-3M Scotch-Brite Light Duty Cleaning Pad, 6-Inch by 9-Inch (98)- 20 count, which you can purchase here: <a href="https://www.amazon.com/dp/B000659ODS/ref=cm">https://www.amazon.com/dp/B000659ODS/ref=cm</a> sw r cp tai Wxc5DbASEHWSP

REMEMBER: using acidic, abrasive, or caustic( ex; bleach ) products reduces and eliminates the effectiveness of the sealed surfaces.
